



On the basis of the Rules on granting awards and certificates of the National Institute of Chemistry, we hereby publish the following

## **CALL for the "Pregl Award of the National Institute of Chemistry for Outstanding Doctoral Thesis in Chemistry and Related Sciences".**

The Pregl Award comprises a plaque and a financial award of €1,000.

Researchers who have successfully completed their doctoral thesis in the field of chemistry and related sciences, no more than three years before the date of the competition (from September 21 onwards), are eligible to participate in the Call for Outstanding Doctoral Thesis. Candidates may apply for the call a maximum of two times. On the basis of the applications received, a committee will determine a shortlist of candidates for the Pregl Award for Outstanding Doctoral Thesis. The selected candidates will present their work at a public hearing at the National Institute of Chemistry.

Submission of applications: **up to and including October 15<sup>th</sup>, 2024, to the email address [preglovenagrade@ki.si](mailto:preglovenagrade@ki.si) in pdf format.**

The application must be accompanied by:

- explanation of the candidate's achievements and his/her bibliography;
- doctoral thesis;
- articles related to doctoral thesis that were published in journals with impact factor;
- list of articles from the Cobiss database;
- list of citations for all articles based on Web of Science (specially mark the articles that relate to doctoral thesis).

The committee will select up to three award winners within two weeks after the public presentation. Award winners will be announced at the event of the National Institute of Chemistry in December 2024.
