On the basis of the Rules on granting awards and certificates of the National Institute of Chemistry, we hereby publish the following

CALL for the

“Pregl Award of the National Institute of Chemistry for Outstanding Doctoral Dissertation in Chemistry and Related Sciences”.

The Pregl Award comprises a plaque and a financial award of €1,000.00.

Researchers who have successfully completed their doctoral dissertations in the field of chemistry and related sciences, no more than three years before the deadline for submission of applications, are eligible to participate in the Call for Outstanding Doctoral Dissertation. Candidates may apply for the Call a maximum of two times. On the basis of the applications received, a Committee will determine a shortlist of candidates for the Pregl Award for Outstanding Doctoral Dissertation. The selected candidates will present their work at a public hearing at the National Institute of Chemistry.

Submission of applications: up to and including 20 November 2020 to the [CALL FOR PREGL AWARDS OF THE NATIONAL INSTITUTE OF CHEMISTRY, National Institute of Chemistry, Hajdrihova 19, 1001 Ljubljana.](#)

The application must be accompanied by:

- an explanation of the achievements of the candidate and their importance;
- one copy of the doctoral dissertation;
- one copy of each of the doctoral dissertation-related articles published in impact factor journals;
- extract of articles from the Cobiss database;
- a citation of all works based on the Web of Science (specifically mark works that are part of the doctorate).

The application must be submitted in one copy. It is desirable that you submit the application in electronic format (.pdf) in addition to the printed form.

The Committee will select up to three winners within two weeks of the presentation. Award winners will be announced at an event at the National Institute of Chemistry, when conditions allow.
